## **Old Business:**

**Food Service** – We need to make signs to put out to remind workers that if you handle money you cannot handle food. Who would like to do this? If you handle food you must have gloves on. Do we need to have 3 people for each shift for the hotdogs and brats or are 2 enough? Jean will contact those who work this stand and discuss it with them.

**Wiffle Ball Toss/Duck Races**: There was a discussion as to whether or not we should do either of these. Tom Birchell is checking with someone who states that there is a license we can fill out that will allow us to do the dice game, he will get this information by the next meeting.

**Wiffle Ball:** If we do the Wiffle Ball game, we need to order more soda, we were short last year, as the game draws more kids and there was less soda then we normally have. Get **cans** not 20 oz bottles. We would also need a chairperson.

**Silent Auction**: We need a chair, people will have to contact the chairperson for them to see what is being donated and if we will accept it, the value of each item should be \$100 or more if possible. Russ Schroeder is interested in helping out.

**Bar - Water**: Order more than 10 cases – at least 20 cases if not more, as the firefighters can always use water during trainings.

**50/50 Raffle**: There was discussion about the possibility of doing a BIG 50/50 Raffle prior to Fun Day with the drawing on Fun Day – either 100 tickets for \$100 each or 200 tickets for \$50 each – winner gets \$5000.00/we get \$5000.00. We need a chairperson for this.

#### **New Business:**

Terry had the form for the Ditch Pick-up; he gave it to Jim to give to Rick Sironi.

#### **Fire Chiefs Report:**

Tom Birchell stated that the Department did get the portable pump.

There is currently an EMR training and the Department has 3 people attending it.

There were several Fire/EMS runs since the September meeting.

The Department has been discussing replacing their Rescue Truck. This will be at a cost of over \$100,000.00. The current one is getting on in years; the Department would like to replace it with one that will be capable of holding extrication equipment, which is currently spread out between multiple vehicles. They would also like one big enough to transport a minimum of 6 personnel. When the time comes, they will be coming to FF Inc for financial support for a portion of the cost.
